
Announcement is made of the following award:

Reason: For exceptionally meritorious service. During the period 1 April 2003 to 1 April 2004, Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 467th Quartermaster Battalion displayed exceptionally meritorious service while in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. The battalion was assigned non-traditional missions such as Coalition-Joint Reception, staging, onward movement, area direct support, maintenance support throughout Kuwait, and operation of four contingency camps in North Kuwait. The Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 467th Quartermaster Battalion supported over 45,000 coalition Soldiers moving through Kuwait, provided over 1800 direct support maintenance, recovery, or retrograde missions, and maintained very functional camps supporting over 17 Army and 2 Marine Brigades moving through Kuwait.
