

SUBJECT: Army Superior Unit Award (ASUA) – PERMANENT ORDERS

1. The recommendation for award of the ASUA to the Joint Attack Munition Systems Project Office, U.S. Army Program Office, Missiles and Space has been approved.
2. The U.S. Army Program Executive Office, Missiles and Space was not registered as an official unit designation until 20 February 2007. Prior to this, the unit's official designation was the U.S. Army Program Executive Office, Tactical Missiles. Consequently, two sets of orders were generated to account for the change in designation and to ensure that all intended personnel were recognized for the full duration of the ASUA. Order number 229-07, dated 17 August 2010, authorizes award of the ASUA to the Joint Attack Munition Systems Project Office, U.S. Army Program Executive Office, Tactical Missiles for the period 5 December 2006 to 19 February 2007. Order number 229-08, dated 17 August 2010, authorizes award of the ASUA to the Joint Attack Munition Systems Project Office, U.S. Army Program Executive Office, Missiles and Space for the period 20 February 2007 to 5 March 2008.
3. The permanent orders, citation, certificate(s), and streamer(s) authorized for the unit(s) included in this award are enclosed. Individual ribbons (emblems) should be procured through local supply channels. Permanent wear of the ASUA for military personnel is governed by the provisions of AR 670-1.
